3rd Annual **Golf Ball Drop**

RULES AND PROCEDURES

The Little Red House, Inc., a nonprofit corporation whose mission is to provide adult day care services in a home-like environment for individuals with physical, cognitive, and psychosocial limitations, will hold a Golf Ball Drop fundraiser on Monday, May 19, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. at Spring Lake Country Club, 17496 North Fruitport Road, Spring Lake, Michigan.

Procedures:

1. The general public is invited to purchase golf balls as follows: 1 ball for \$10, 6 balls for \$50, or 13 balls for \$100. Purchasers of golf balls will hereinafter be referred to as "participants."
2. Each participant will receive a receipt for his or her purchase; said receipt will indicate the unique number which will be written on each ball purchased by participant. The participant must keep receipt. The Raffle Chair will be responsible for numbering the balls and placing them in a bin, which will be securely stored by said Chair.
3. The Raffle Chair will log the names of all participants and the numbers assigned to their golf balls.
4. For the golf ball drop, a lift truck will be used.
5. An officer of the organization will be raised in a bucket truck with the bin of balls to a height of more than 10 feet over a golf green located at the Spring Lake Country Club.
6. At 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as is possible, the bin will be turned over and the balls dropped to the green below, where there will be one golf hole with a flag.
7. A standard tape measure (measuring feet and inches) will be used to determine the balls closest to the hole.

Rules:

1. Balls may be purchased until 5:45 p.m. on Monday, May 19, 2008.
2. Participants need not be present to win.
3. In the event of rain, the golf ball drop will go on as scheduled. In the event of lightning, or other weather that creates a danger to the participants or those conducting the ball drop, the drop will be conducted the following day at the same time.
4. The ball that lands closest to the hole is the winner. Second closest to the hole is the second place winner. Third closest to the hole is the third place winner.
5. In the event that more than one ball goes into the hole during the drop, the green will be cleared of all balls and only those balls that dropped into hole will be inserted in the bin and there will be a re-drop to determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. If only two balls need to be redropped, then closest to the hole on redrop determines first place and the next ball is second place and the ball that was closest, but not in the hole, on the first drop becomes the third place winner.
6. PRIZES: First Place: \$1,000; Second Place: \$400; Third Place: \$200
7. In the event that a total of 500 balls are not sold, the prize money will drop to: First Place, \$400; Second Place, \$200; Third Place: \$100.
